Recommendation: consider using the Yogyakarta Principles on the Application of International Human Rights Law in relation to sexual Orientation and Gender Identity as a guide to assist in its policies development. (recommended by Slovenia)

Response: The delegation of Finland stated that her Government had studied the Yogyakarta Principles and stated that they are a useful tool to bring clarity and coherence to States' human rights obligations. Finland agreed to follow up on the recommendation.
